CATEGORIES

Bed Pieced Quilt

Quilt must be predominately pieced; traditional or contemporary in design.
Width greater than or equal to 70"; no limit on length.

Bed Appliqué Quilt

Quilts must be predominately appliqué (including machine and fused)
Width greater than or equal to 70"; no limit on length.

Lap Pieced Quilt

Quilt must be predominately pieced; traditional or contemporary in design
Width is 49 " to 69"; no limit on length

Lap Appliqué Quilt

Quilt must be predominately Quilt must be predominately appliquéd (including machine and fused)
Width is 49 " to 69"; no limit on length
(including machine and fused)
Width is 49 " to 69"; no limit on length

Wall-Hanging Pieced

Quilt must be predominately pieced, traditional or contemporary in design.
With is up to 49"; no limit on length

Wall-Hanging Applique

Quilt must be predominately appliquéd (including machine and fused)
Width is up to 49"; no limit on length

Art Quilt

Other

This category includes miniature quilts, red work, whole cloth quilts, wearable and home fashions.

Special Guild Challenge

This category honors the results of the guild's challenge to its members. The guild issues its own challenge to its members choosing size, rules, fabrics, themes or whatever!

Look What I did in Class!

Any project that was begun at a Guild sponsored Workshop. The quilt does not have to have been completed at the workshop. The Workshop must have been held after the last quilt show.

DEFINITIONS

Appliqué Quilts: small pieces of fabric are sewn (hand or machine) or fused to a background fabric to form designs. Appliqué may be combined with pieced blocks.

Art Quilts: Works of art, displaying innovative, contemporary design and materials, using fabric as the primary medium, quilted by hand or machine

Domestic Machine Quilting: quilts that have been quilted on a home sewing machine

Hand Quilting: quilt done with small even running stitches that are stitched through all three layers of the quilt to hold them together and arranged to form a quilting pattern

Long-arm Machine Quilting: quilts that have been quilted on a commercial quilting machine with an all over or custom quilting design

Pieced Quilts: most commonly seen quilt type, which is made up of many small pieces of fabric sewn together by hand or machine.
