**Beyond the Basics** Once you're comfortable with the basics let's try Feathers, Borders, Mini-Fills, Snowflakes and more... Bring your rulers plus I'll have a variety available for you to try. Learn the tips for these amazing rulers which help you create professional looking quilt designs without the years of practice.

### Supplies:

- \* ¼" Free-motion Ruler Foot for your model of machine
- any Westalee Rulers you own
- \* "slider" sheet [I have Sew Slip brand 18x 12 for \$28.75]
- straight-stitch needle plate [optional but really helps- purchase from your machine dealer]
- \*\* Plexi-glass quilters table [I can order but you need a 3 weeks since they're made to order]
- \* 90/14 Topstitch needles [bring several and have a new one in your machine]
- \* "grippy" fingertips or gloves [optional but helpful]
- \* Crosshair marking ruler [optional, You can borrow to try]
- All-purpose polyester thread or 50w cotton – bring several colors, types if you have; not too dark
- \*Fabric markers that will show on your choice of fabric colors
- At least 6 fat-quarter sandwiches – solid, med. colors are best so ruler white lines show.
- Recommended - A cushion to sit on will bring you to a better height [or an adjustable height chair]

Also: A pencil and some plain paper to work out new designs.

Optional: A project to quilt, could be new or an older item to add more quilting to, even the dog's quilt but please wash first!

\*I will have these items available for sale. \*\* Tables need to be ordered several weeks ahead, so plan accordingly.
